Doug Brewster, Maitland Reserve grade half back, continues to show good form, which could force his way into the higher grade.

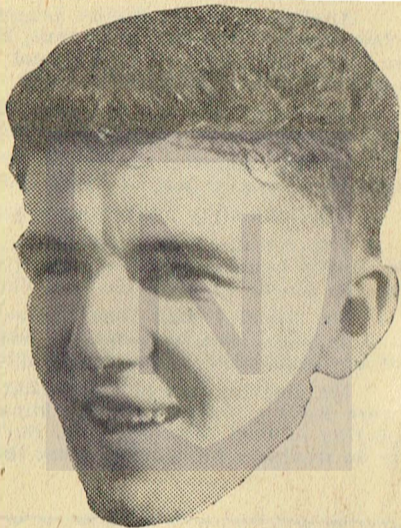
